



Moorestown Friends School is pleased to announce the acquisition of the former Acme supermarket building on Chester Avenue and the property at 66 East Main Street, effective December 15, 2006.

To the Moorestown Community:

December 15 was a momentous day in the history of Moorestown Friends School as we finalized the purchase of the former Acme on Chester Avenue and a smaller property located at 66 East Main Street. As a native Moorestonian, I feel strongly that our educational use of these properties will prove to be another feather in the cap of our fine community.

Moorestown Friends School has been providing a rigorous and spiritually-grounded education to area students since 1785. We currently enroll 725 students in preschool through grade 12, including over 200 Moorestonians. A campus master plan completed last spring identified a need for 30,000 square feet of additional classroom and laboratory space. These properties will help us meet our space needs.

During the next few months, the school will conduct a comprehensive analysis to determine the best use of these new properties. We have hired Voith & Mactavish Architects and Aegis Property Group to work with us during this process. In the interim, we will be lighting, maintaining and cleaning the former Acme and surrounding parking area.

We are eager to contribute further to one of the greatest towns in America by renovating the former Acme to provide an appealing gateway to Main Street, while enhancing the MFS campus and curriculum.
